Girl HQ Troop Fundraising Steps

Steps	Task/Activity		
Step 1	 Get to Know Girl HQ Visit girlscoutsnyc.org/GirlHQ to learn about Girl HQ plans and why it's important for your troop to get involved. 		
Step 2	 Prepare Your Troop for Fundraising Introduce Girl HQ and the campaign to your troop. Watching this campaign video together is a great way to start the discussion. Recruit interested adult volunteers to lead fundraising efforts. With input from the troop, choose your fundraising activities and schedule them. 		
Step 3	Register Your Troop Fundraiser(s) • Register your fundraiser(s) with the council by contacting Patrick Tekula at GirlHQ@ girlscoutsnyc.org and providing the following information: o Troop # o Troop Leader(s) Name and Contact (phone and email) o # of Girls Scouts in your troop o Fundraiser type and a brief description of your plan o Fundraiser date, time, and location o Fundraiser goal (\$)		
Step 4	Promote Your Fundraiser • Promote your fundraiser by word of mouth, email, social media, etc.		
Step 5	Conduct Your Fundraiser(s) • Encourage all members of the troop to participate in the fundraiser and take ownership of its success. • Conduct your troop fundraiser. • Share fundraising results with the troop. • Report your fundraising results to Council by contacting Patrick Tekula at GirlHQ@ girlscoutsnyc.org. Please include the following information: □ Troop # □ Troop Leader(s) Name and Contact (phone and email) □ # of Girls Scouts in your troop □ Fundraiser date □ Fundraiser goal (\$) and results (\$) □ Any photos or videos of your fundraiser		
Step 6	Celebrate your success and acknowledge your Girls Scouts and adult volunteers for their efforts!		

Troop Fundraising Recognition

By holding a troop fundraiser for Girl HQ, you can make your mark on the new building in more ways than one! Here are the levels of recognition your troop can earn.

Total Raised	Troop Recognition	Description
\$100-499	Commemorative Girl HQ Patch	All Girl Scout troops and volunteers that raise \$100-499 will receive a commemorative Campaign for Girl HQ Patch.
\$500	Paver Stones	Carve your name, your troop name, tribute, or memory into paver stones and they will become part of the Girl HQ landscape.
\$1,000	Trees	Troops and/or individuals will be acknowledged with the planting of a tree. Each tree will be distinguished with a personalized tree plaque.
\$2,500	Classroom Tables	Troops and/or individuals will be recognized in a Girl HQ classroom for providing classroom tables. Each table will be distinguished with a personalized table plaque.
\$3,000	Benches	A bench is a wonderful way to create a lifetime memory for your troop, or to commemorate a meaningful Girl Scout Camp experience. Troops and/or individuals will be recognized for providing for the installation and maintenance of a bench at Camp Kaufmann.
\$5,000	Dining Hall Tables	Troops and/or individuals will be recognized in the Girl HQ dining hall for providing dining tables. Each table will be distinguished with a personalized table plaque.

Keep the FUN in FUNdraising! Plan fundraisers that the whole troop can get excited about and take part in. The best fundraisers will be the ones that work best for your troop and community. Don't be afraid to get creative and think outside the box. Here are some ideas to inspire your creativity:

- Invite friends and family to make a donation.
- Host a bake sale or pancake breakfast.
- Organize a yard, garage, or stoop sale.
- Have a car wash or pet wash.
- Offer holiday gift wrapping services.
- Facilitate a badge workshop for younger Girl Scouts.
- Host a talent show or fashion show.
- Open a craft fair.
- Offer yard work or neighborhood clean-up.
- Host a Fun Run/Walk and offer sponsorships.
- Have a Dance-a-thon.
- Set up a fundraising booth at a local establishment.
- Set up a lemonade stand at the park.
- Have a Read-a-thon.
