Brooklyn Bridge & Jane's Carousel	The World-Famous Brooklyn Bridge! When it was built, it was the longest suspension bridge in the world and a groundbreaking feat of engineering. Plan your visit and take a stroll over the bridge to Jane's Carousel, nestled in a stunning glass pavilion beneath the bridge. This charming antique carousel features 48 beautifully carved horses and two chariots, offering a nostalgic ride with incredible views!	All
Smorgasburg	Come hungry! Williamsburg and Prospect Park host the largest weekly open-air food market in America. Each weekend, you can eat from hundreds of local vendors representing food and drinks from across the globe.	All
Brooklyn Heights Promenade	Just sit and enjoy the view! This pedestrian walkway offers great views of Downtown Manhattan. The Promenade is lined with grand town houses and mansions. This is part of Brooklyn's first Historic Preservation District.	All
Barclays Center	Home of the Brooklyn Nets and NY Liberty! <u>Barclays Center</u> is an award winning, state-of-the-art arena that serves as the home of the NBA's Brooklyn Nets and the WNBA's New York Liberty. With its intimate seating design, it offers an unforgettable experience for fans of all kinds!	All

Prospect Park	A walk in the park! Participate in outdoor activities like hiking and bird watching at <u>Prospect Park</u> . Yes, bird watching! Be sure to visit the park's Audubon Center and enjoy environmental programs.	All

NY Transit Museum	Housed underground in an authentic 1936 subway station! <u>The New</u> <u>York Transit Museum</u> is dedicated to telling and preserving the stories of mass transportation – extraordinary engineering feats, workers worked in the tunnels over 100 years ago, communities that were drastically transformed, and the ever-evolving technology, design, and ridership of a system that runs 24 hours a day, every day of the year! Fort Greene Park	Originally the site of forts built for the Revolutionary War Dig into the deep history of Fort Greene Park, and you will unearth a wealth of brave, passionate, creative Americans. Step foot on its grounds, and you will be inspired as you become part of its history!	All
